### JUDGING CRITERIA 2012

#### **A1 LIST**

For persons who have previously been appointed by the Kennel Club to award Challenge Certificates in the breed and have the support of the Southern Miniature Bull Terrier Club.

#### **A2 LIST**

For persons who fulfil all the requirements of the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with the Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on the A" list and have the support of the Southern Miniature Bull Terrier Club.

#### **A3 LIST**

##### **BREED SPECIALIST**

1. To have a minimum of 10 years interest in Miniature Bull Terriers and 7 years judging experience in the breed and to have the support of the Southern Miniature Bull Terrier Club.
2. To have judged at least 1 SMBTC or MBTC Breed Show.
3. To have judged a minimum of 23 classes of Miniature Bull Terriers.
4. To have judged a minimum of 40 Miniature Bull Terriers.
5. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel club Stud Book. (Save in exceptional circumstances).
6. To have stewarded at 12 shows.
7. To have attended a Miniature Bull Terrier Seminar.
8. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the relevant examinations on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures.
9. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement Hands on Assessment
10. To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.

##### **NON SPECIALIST**

1. Minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed (including at least 5 years in this breed) and to have the support of the Southern Miniature Bull Terrier Club.
2. To have judged a minimum of 20 classes of Miniature Bull Terriers.
3. To have judged a minimum of 30 Miniature Bull Terriers.
4. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs of any breed when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel club Stud Book. (Save in exceptional circumstances).
5. To have stewarded at 12 shows.
6. To have attended a Miniature Bull Terrier Seminar.
7. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the relevant examinations on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures.
8. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement Hands on Assessment.
9. To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.
10. To have awarded Challenge Certificates in at least one other breed.

#### **B LIST**

##### **BREED SPECIALIST**

1. To have 5 years experience of owning or exhibiting a Miniature Bull Terrier and to have the support of the Southern Miniature Bull Terrier Club.
2. To have judged 4 classes of Miniature Bull Terriers at Open or Limit Shows or at a Championship Shows without Challenge Certificates and to have judged a minimum of 8 Miniature Bull Terriers or to have attended a Southern Miniature Bull Terrier Show as a trainee judge (attend the judge of the day who will be from the A list and who will mentor) .
3. Have completed a stewarding appointment. .
4. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and

passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures.

5. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement.

6. To have attended and passed a Hands on Assessment run by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer.

7. To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.

#### NON SPECIALIST

1. To have 7 years experience of owning or exhibiting dogs and to have the support of the Southern Miniature Bull Terrier Club.

2. To have judged 2 classes of Miniature Bull Terriers at Open or Limit or at a Championship Shows without Challenge Certificates and to have judged a minimum of 4 Miniature Bull Terriers or to have attended a Southern Miniature Bull Terrier Show as a trainee judge (attend the judge of the day who will be from the A list who will mentor) and to be on a B List of another breed.

3. Have completed a stewarding appointment

4. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the relevant examinations on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures.

5. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement.

6. To have attended and passed a Hands on Assessment run by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer.

7. To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.
